Funding

Each studentship will cover full-time tuition fees for three years, with an annual stipend of £15,609

Eligibility

Applicants must have a good honours degree (2.1 or equivalent). The studentship will only fully fund applicants who are eligible for UK fees.

Supporting documentation: you will need to upload your research proposal, all your degree certificates and transcripts and your proof of English language proficiency as attachments to your application so please have these available when you complete the application form.

References: you will need to provide details of two referees as part of your application. At least one referee must be an academic referee from the institution that conferred your highest degree. Your referee will be asked for a reference at the time you submit your application, so please ensure that your nominated referees are

willing and able to provide references within 14 days of your application being submitted.
